Based in Brooklyn, NY, Division of Planes balances noise with melody in a tense and intricate manner. Their early material layered Tom's skillful yet fractured guitar over the tight rhythms Thomas and Jerel had developed. Within their first two months as a band eight songs were written and Division of Planes was in a supporting slot of a small East Coast tour.

Immediately after their first summer together, the band began writing more integrated and direct material. In October 2005, Division of Planes recorded the tightly rhythmic and tunelessly dissonant "Disarray" as an mp3 single with engineer Ted Young (Andrew WK, The Hold Steady) at Water Music Records in New Jersey. On the strength of this recording, and the impression they made on touring bands, the Division of Planes played shows on the West Coast and various venues around New York City.

Division of Planes entered the studio again in the Fall of 2006, this time with engineer Scott Norton (Coco Rosie, The Mink Lungs, Early Man) at his place Headgear Recordings in Brooklyn. Using the studio's Trident 80C console they recorded live, with the exception of vocals and minor overdubs, direct to a Pro Tools Mix Plus System. A month later, the 6 tracks of *Trembling Wires* were mixed at Headgear — once again by Scott. The EP was mastered by TJ Lipple (The Evens, Medications, and Wilderness) at Silver Sonya in Arlington, VA.

The band released *Trembling Wires* on their own imprint Divided by Records in July 2007.

Division of Planes has achieved distinctive results: no single aspect from the early disjunctive art punk of Gang of Four, Wire and Mission of Burma, or the driving 90s guitar of Jawbox, Chavez, and At the Drive-in, or the revitalizations of punk contemporaries Hot Snakes, the Blood Brothers, or Parts & Labor dominates *Trembling Wires*, and yet fans of these bands will have something to hang their ear on.
